WORSHIP

Scripture: Psalm 2:1-12

Theme: God is the Ultimate Ruler over all

WORD

Read: Acts 12:1-25

1. In the first century, preaching the gospel was a dangerous adventure. Explain what happened to James; and why. Explain what happened to Peter; and why. (See v. 1-4)
2. How was Peter set free from prison? What part did the church have in Peter's release?
3. Has there ever been a time when you were "in prison" (either literally or figuratively) and Jesus set you free? Encourage one another by sharing your story!
4. Have you ever experience a miraculous answer to prayer? Share your experience. Were you surprised as the early church was when God answered their prayers? (See v. 12-16)
5. What became of Herod? Why did this happen to him? (Read also Gal. 6:7-8). What does this tell you about our God? How does this make you feel about God?
6. As a result of these events, what happened to the church?

WITNESS

- Read Matthew 9:37-38. The Harvest is plentiful. All around us are people waiting to receive the good news of Jesus. It is the workers who are few.
- Pray for God to raise up workers for the Harvest.
- Brainstorm about how you can become one of the workers. What do you need? Training? A willing heart? Help prioritizing your time?
- Commit to one another to take the next step in becoming a worker.
